Re. Firs Farm Playing Field River Restoration – Phase 1

Dear Resident

We write to you to inform you of improvements to your local park. We are undertaking a river restoration project to the watercourse in Firs Farm Playing Fields.

The work will involve the creation of an open stream in the northern part of the park which currently has an underground stream running through it. Phase 1 will enhance the park by introducing a watercourse with natural features and the improvement of an existing flood defence bund on the eastern boundary. Phase 2 is planned to be carried out in 2015, this will provide additional crossing points and wetland features.

The work is scheduled to start on the 26th August 2014 and will last approximately 6 weeks. Work will be carried out during normal working hours only and every effort will be made to ensure that noise and disruption is kept to a minimum.

A strip along the northern and eastern edge of the park will be closed to public access for the duration of the work, this will be clearly indicated by fencing and signs. The sports pitches will not be adversely affected.
