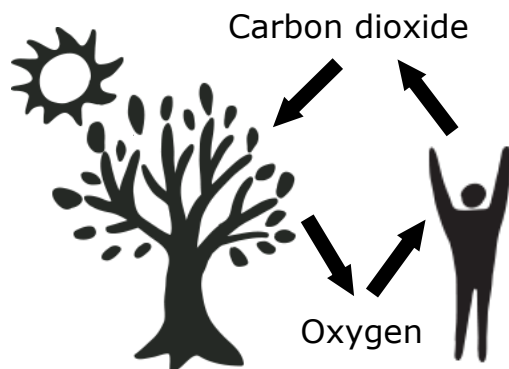


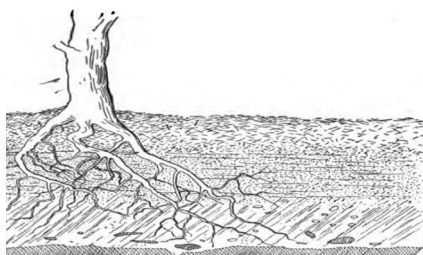
## Why we need trees

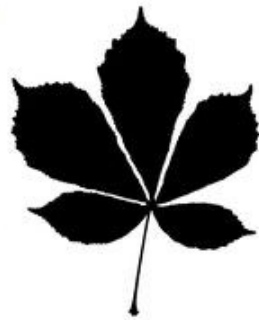

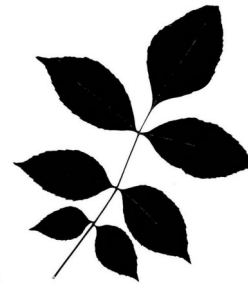
