How to do a bark rubbing

You will need:

- A large piece of paper—not too thick
- A wax crayon, dark colours are best
- Someone to help hold the paper while you rub!



How to do it:

- When you find a tree get someone to hold the paper of the tree.
- Using the crayon on its side rub hard all over the paper

Leaf rubbings

You can also do leaf rubbings.

- Collect some leaves, go to the picnic table
- Lay the leaves on the table.
- Cover with paper and rub you crayon over the leaves.
