

# Fabulous fungi top trumps

#### Will you come out on top?

First, you'll need two or more players.

Next, shuffle all the cards and deal them – remember to keep them face down. Each player should only be able to see the stats on their top card.

Player one reads out an item and statistic from their top card (e.g. toxicity 8). The other players take turns to read out their stats for the same item. The player with the highest number wins, and adds all the top cards to the bottom of their pile.

The winner chooses a category from their next card and plays again.

If two or more cards share the highest number, all the cards from that round are thrown in the middle and the round starts again. The winner takes all the cards in the middle.

Remember, some fungi are extremely poisonous, so never touch them.


Fun fact: a 'bracket' fungus that grows on trees – often found on oaks

Fun fact: When this fungus opens out it looks like a spacecraft on stilts

# Common bird's nest



Fun fact: looks like a bird's nest – keep your eyes peeled for tiny eggs when the 'nest' splits open

## Common puffball

Fun fact: puffballs burst once they mature, releasing a cloud of brown, dusty spores

# Crab brittlegill

Colour 7
Rarity 4

Sliminess 5
Smell 10
Toxicity 0

Fun fact: super stinky! Has a fishy smell that gets stronger as the fungus gets older
